Professor Isnard Bagnis is also a leader in digital health transformation. She founded UNIREIN, a national “third-place” infrastructure dedicated to the real-world evaluation of healthcare innovations, supporting the integration of emerging technologies into clinical practice in a meaningful and sustainable way.

In parallel with her clinical and academic work, she has been a pioneer in integrating contemplative sciences into medical education. Trained in mindfulness at the Center for Mindfulness in Boston and in compassion-based approaches, she established university programs that have trained hundreds of healthcare professionals, promoting well-being, resilience, and improved quality of care.

Her professional focus centers on redesigning healthcare systems to better align technological innovation with human-centered, sustainable medical practice. She is widely recognized for her contributions to advancing both clinician well-being and patient-centered care within modern healthcare systems.
