



## **Jose M. Martin-Moreno, MD, PhD, MPH, DrPH**

Professor of Medicine and Public Health, University of Valencia Director, Chair in Innovative Health Management, Economy and Health Foundation Coordinator for European and Global Health Policies, ECO Foundation Spain

Prof. Jose M. Martin-Moreno is Professor of Medicine and Public Health at the University of Valencia, where he also serves as Director of the Chair in Innovative Health Management within the Economy and Health Foundation, and as Coordinator for European and Global Health Policies at the ECO Foundation. With a strong academic foundation including an MD and PhD from the University of Granada and advanced postgraduate degrees from Harvard University, his work spans epidemiology, non-communicable diseases, public health systems, and health policy and management.

Professor Martin-Moreno has held numerous senior leadership roles at both national and international levels. He previously served as Director-General and Chief Medical Officer of the Government of Spain, and as Director of Programme Management at the WHO Regional Office for Europe. He has also advised key European institutions, including the European Commission (DG SANTE and DG Research) and the Scientific and Technical Office of the European Parliament, contributing to the development of public health policy across the region.

He is a past President of the Association of Schools of Public Health in the European Region (ASPHER) and served for 18 years as Senior Associate at the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, with joint appointments in Health Policy and Management and Epidemiology. His contributions to academia include authorship of more than 450 scientific publications in leading journals such as The New England Journal of Medicine, The Lancet, Nature, and BMJ.

Professor Martin-Moreno currently serves as Cancer Policy Adviser to the European Observatory on Health Systems and Policies and is a member of the European Academy of Cancer Sciences. He is also affiliated with the Royal Academy of Medicine of the Valencian Community and Spain's Royal National Academy of Medicine, and is an Honorary Fellow of the UK Royal College of Physicians / Faculty of Public Health.

His work has been widely recognised with prestigious distinctions, including the Harvard Alumni Award of Merit, the Spanish Grand Cross of the Civil Order of Health, and the Andrija Stampar Award and Medal for lifetime distinguished contributions to public health.
