Dr. Muneer Alobeidli is a UAE-based entrepreneur, strategist, and institutional builder working at the intersection of workforce wellbeing, education, and human capacity development. As Founder and CEO of Future Wellbeing - the UAE's first Emirati-built wellbeing platform - he leads the development of end-to-end physical and digital solutions that span the full wellbeing ecosystem, from culture activation and awareness to governance frameworks, compliance infrastructure, and measurable organizational outcomes across healthcare, government, and corporate sectors in the UAE and GCC.

Dr. Alobeidli is recognized for his ability to embed wellbeing into the core infrastructure of organizations, transforming it from an aspirational concept into a measurable, system-level practice. His methodology - Assess, Define, Structure, System, Measure, Improve - enables institutions to align workforce wellbeing with performance, compliance, and long-term sustainability. He has been particularly influential in linking wellbeing to organizational metrics, developing regulatory-aligned frameworks, and building scalable digital wellbeing systems for complex enterprises.

Beyond his entrepreneurial work, Dr. Alobeidli plays an active role in shaping national and regional agendas. As a Board Member of the Finance Emiratisation Think Tank, powered by AICPA & CIMA, he contributes to advancing financial wellbeing and talent development for the next generation of Emirati professionals. He also serves on the Advisory Board of Wellbeing for Doctors, supporting the development of global standards for clinician wellbeing and peer support.

His leadership extends across sectors, including his role in driving wellbeing and occupational health strategy within the telecommunications industry, as well as his earlier contributions to establishing one of the region's first dedicated organizational wellbeing functions and advancing wellbeing governance at the national level. His work is closely aligned with the UAE National Wellbeing Strategy 2031, with a focus on building scalable, locally rooted models that position the UAE as a global leader in wellbeing innovation.
