Dr. Patricia Udaondo Mirete graduated in Medicine and Surgery from Miguel Hernández University of Elche. She completed her specialty training in Ophthalmology at Hospital General Universitario de Valencia, where she was awarded the prize for the best academic record of her graduating class.

Her clinical career began at Hospital General Universitario de Valencia and continued at Hospital Universitario La Fe in Valencia, where she currently works as part of the medical and surgical retina team. Her clinical focus includes vitreoretinal surgery, retinal diseases, cataract surgery, and medical retina pathology.

Dr. Udaondo is co-founder and co-director of Aiken in Valencia and serves as president of the Aiken Foundation. She is actively involved in academic teaching, having collaborated in multiple master's programs and served as an associate professor at CEU Cardenal Herrera University. She is currently an associate professor of Ophthalmology at the University of Valencia.

She is an active contributor to national and international ophthalmology conferences and forums, and has published extensively in peer-reviewed ophthalmology journals as both author and reviewer. Her contributions to the field have been recognized with several awards, including the Achievement Award from the American Academy of Ophthalmology for her collaboration and contributions to the academy.

Recently, she joined the board of the European Society of Retina Specialists (EURETINA) as the representative for Spain.

Her main areas of interest include cataract surgery, vitreoretinal surgery, and medical retina. She is particularly committed to the prevention and management of retinal diseases such as diabetic retinopathy and age-related macular degeneration, with a strong focus on early diagnosis, disease control, and slowing progression.
