Dr. Joseph Nyaga Njagi is an endometriosis specialist and gynaecological surgeon with a strong focus on minimally invasive surgery and multidisciplinary women's healthcare. His clinical work centres on the diagnosis, surgical treatment, and long-term multidisciplinary management of endometriosis, with particular emphasis on improving access to specialised care across Kenya and East Africa.

He currently serves as Director of 3rd Park Hospital in Nairobi and Maple Grove Gynecological Centre in Kerugoya. Through these leadership roles, he has contributed to the development of integrated models of care that combine advanced surgical practice with coordinated multidisciplinary management for women with complex gynaecological conditions.

Dr. Njagi is a founding member of the Pan-African Society of Endometriosis (PASE) and the African Centre for Endometriosis (ACE), both established to strengthen awareness, diagnosis, treatment, and collaborative care for endometriosis across Africa. He is also Founder of the Laparoscopy Mashinani Trust Fund, an initiative dedicated to expanding access to laparoscopic surgery for rural and underserved communities.

He currently serves as Vice Chair of the Kenyan Society of Endoscopic Specialists and is a Board Member of the International Federation of Gynecology and Obstetrics (FIGO) Minimally Invasive Surgery Committee. Through these roles, he contributes to advancing surgical standards, professional education, and wider access to minimally invasive gynaecological care across the region.

Dr. Njagi is actively engaged in academic and professional development. He is currently undertaking a Fellowship in Gynaecological Oncology at the University of Nairobi and is also a Doctoral Fellow in Healthcare Management at Strathmore University. He previously completed his specialist training in Obstetrics and Gynaecology at Mbarara University of Science and Technology in Uganda.

An internationally recognised speaker and educator, Dr. Njagi is committed to advancing women's health through clinical innovation, education, and cross-border collaboration.
