Professor Mihaela Grigore is a Professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the “Grigore T. Popa” University of Medicine and Pharmacy in Iasi. She graduated from the Faculty of General Medicine at the same institution and completed her specialist training in obstetrics and gynaecology within the same academic centre.

Throughout her professional development, Professor Grigore complemented her clinical training in Romania with advanced international fellowships focused on key areas of women’s health. These included minimally invasive surgery at Hospital Saint-Antoine in Paris, cervical pathology at Vanderbilt University in Nashville and Frauenklinik Freiburg in Germany, infertility at McGill University in Montreal, and breast surgery at Institut Curie in Paris.

Her clinical practice has been closely integrated with academic teaching and research. This commitment led to the award of the title of Doctor of Medicine in 2000 and her appointment as University Professor in 2020. Her professional interests include minimally invasive gynaecological surgery, cervical pathology, infertility, and the advancement of evidence-based clinical practice.

Professor Grigore has made substantial contributions to medical research through the publication of monographs, books, and scientific papers in leading specialist journals, as well as presentations at national and international scientific congresses. Her research work has also included active participation in international collaborative networks. She is a member of the Cochrane Gynaecology and Fertility Group and a founding member of Cochrane Romania.

In recognition of her contribution to medical innovation and professional leadership, she received the Medical Entrepreneurship Award at the Medica Gala in 2014.
